DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

The Programme is of two semesters spread over one year duration starting from June to end in March. Classes for First semester shall be started by June in all affiliated institutions. Classes for Second semester begins by November. The minimum number of working days in each semester shall be 100 including days of admission and examinations. Examination will be conducted at the end of each semester.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Admission to the course is restricted to Muslim women candidates only. Age limit for the course shall be from 17 to 35. Optional subjects are categorized as General and Arabic & Islamic. Candidates seeking admission to general category shall be required to have passed Plus Two / VHSE / Pre-Degree / Open Degree courses with 50 percentage of marks.

Students who passed Afzal Ululama preliminary, Wafiya, Zahraviyya, Falila, B.A Arabic and any other course approved by Albirr state Board with 50 percentage can apply for Arabic & Islamic category. In absence of sufficient qualified candidates, students who passed plus two with Arabic as second language will be considered for admission for Arabic and Islamic category.

The candidates waiting the result can apply for the course. But they shall be eligible for the course at the time of interview.



CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

Notification for the course will be published at beginning of April each year and candidates are expected to apply for the course online/ offline. Offline application can be submitted at any Albirr Teacher Training center along with fee for application. The fee for application shall be 500/. Interview will be conducted at selected centres during third week of May and rank list will be published. Admission to the course shall be regulated on the basis of merit assessed by giving weightage of 75:25 to the mark obtained in the qualifying exam (Plus Two, Aflalul Ulamah, Wafiyya etc.) and the marks obtained for teaching aptitude test or interview. Admission will be made based on centralized allotment system.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

Medium of instruction shall be English for all courses except Arabic, Islamic and Malayalam. However, in case of Arabic, Islamic and Malayalam, instruction will be given in the language concerned. Medium of examination shall be English/Malayalam. The language Optional papers shall be written in the language specified in the guestion paper.

ATTENDANCE

A student shall be considered to have satisfactory attendance to appear for the examination if she attends not less than 85% for all theory classes and 100% for practical. Shortage of 10% attendance can be condoned by Albirr State examination board for medical emergency on production of medical certificate. Candidates thus apply for condonation shall remit 100 rupees per each day's shortage.

MODE OF EVALUATION

Both internal and external stream of evaluation will be followed. There shall be theory exam at the end of each semester. CCE will be the part of process. The pass mark for theory is 50% aggregate and 40% in each paper for TE and CE separately and 60% for practical. For each theory paper 80% for TE and 20% marks for CE will be provided. Say examination will be conducted for failed candidates. The candidates shall apply for examination by remitting prescribed fee.

PRACTICAL EXAMINATION AND VIVA VOCE

Practical examination will be conducted in each semester by an External Examination Board constituted by Albirr STE joint director. The board will consist of a Chairman, and a Subject expert. The subject expert for the Optional Paper will conduct Practical Examination for the concerned Optional. The board shall examine all the practicals of each student, standardize internal marks allotted by the institution and make corrections, if necessary. Each student should attend the viva-voce on pedagogy of their subject (for 50 marks) in first semester. In second semester, the board shall observe and assess the teaching competency of all candidates for a maximum of 50 marks and conduct a Viva-Voce on the subject. The duration of the Practical Examination in an institution will be two days for 50 students. Additional days will be provided depending on the intake of the institution.





RE-ADMISSION RULES

Those candidates who discontinue the course can be given the provision of readmission if otherwise eligible as long as the same scheme exists. There shall be provision for readmission in the same institution in the second semester within a period of three years for those who have satisfactorily completed first, provided there is vacancy in the institution and the syllabus being the same. Re-admission shall be permitted during the first week of 2nd, semester.

UNIFORM

There shall be uniform for students. All affiliated institutions shall follow uniform prescribed for Albirr preschool teachers.
